

Dancer Dress Code

Lyrical	Any Solid Color Leotard – Skirts/Shorts/Leggings Are Permitted	Any Color	Half Sole Lyrical Shoes or Tan Jazz Shoes

All ballet students use ballet slippers regardless of level. Please bring them the first week of class.

Ballet slippers & tap shoes WITHOUT ties are best for our students from Pre-K to First Grade. Pointe shoes may be purchased prior to the beginning of class, but students must wait until class to begin working with their pointe shoes.

Dance sweaters or zip-up sweatshirts are permitted at the beginning of class.

Tight-fitting shirt or tank top is permitted over a leotard for jazz or tap.

Hooded sweatshirts, sweatpants, and loose-fitting tops ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Skirts for young children should be attached to the leotard so that they do not become a distraction during class.

Students should have their hair secured in a fashion that will not need to be adjust during class. All bows, headbands, and other hair ornaments should be securely placed in the child's hair or removed prior to class. No necklaces or bracelets should be worn during class.

We feel that a proper dress code will allow students to perform better and exhibit increase confidence during weekly class. The dress code will also eliminate distractions from clothing, and students will be expected to adhere to the dress code each week.
